



HIGH FIVES & LITTLE KICKERS PRINT-TAKING INSTRUCTIONS

Dear Customer,

You will find enclosed in your Print-taking Kit the following:

- 1 x inkless wipe (this can be used more than once in one session)
- 1 x sheet of specially coated identifier paper on which to take your prints
- 1 x Order Form

Taking a print couldn't be easier and what's more it is safe and perfectly clean

A LITTLE BIT ABOUT THE INKLESS WIPE SYSTEM

The Inkless Print ID System was developed in the US as a way of taking scannable prints of newborns in hospital for identification purposes. The inkless wipes themselves are clean and easy to use. Simply wipe the child's foot with an inkless wipe and then press it to the identification paper. This paper has a special receptive coating which allows the development of the print. A permanent, unsmudged image is formed almost immediately, and the baby's foot stays clean and dry.

STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS

1. To prepare, place the identification paper onto a smooth, hard surface and wipe the hand or foot you wish to print and allow to dry.
2. Gently wipe your child's hand or foot with the inkless wipe.
3. Gently press the foot onto the sensitised side of the paper (instructions on the paper tell you which side this is).

For footprints – hold the ankle and roll from heel to toe, holding the toes in place with the other hand. Hold down for five seconds and then remove.

For handprints – roll from the heel of the hand near the wrist, to the tips of the fingers, holding the fingers in place briefly before lifting the hand from the paper.

4. Wash both your hands and the child's hand or foot in soapy water.
5. The print will form in 10-15 seconds.

TOP TIPS

- ✓ Be careful not to touch the identification paper until you have washed your hands as it will pick up your prints too! Use one hand to hold the wipe and one to touch the paper.
- ✓ When opened the inkless wipe will feel quite dry to the touch – this is normal.
- ✓ For younger babies it may be easiest if they are asleep or sleepy to avoid them wriggling and to help fingers to stay uncurled. It can also help if one person holds them and another one takes the prints.
- ✓ If you take the print in the top left-hand corner of the paper, you will leave yourself space to have more than one attempt and we can use the best print.
- ✓ Don't open your wipe until you are ready to use it. It can be used a few times but it will dry out quickly once open.
